

# <u>上主日講章簡述</u>

#### 「平凡的聖徒」(雅各書1:17-27)

祈禱過後,我們的行動是什麼?我不能抹熬祈禱的重要 性,但在建立一個仁愛與和平的社會,我們要聽見雅各對我們 的呼喊,讓基督信徒不忘記參與社會的工作。愛上帝的表現是 透過愛鄰舍。社會得著建立要求我們直接的參與。這裡所講的 是信徒慷慨的行為。這行為不僅是基督徒才可以作的。而是所 有的慷慨的行為上帝都欣賞。雅各鼓勵我們對上帝的回應,不 單在理念上接納,乃是要活出來。這給我們帶來了第二點:這 些活動僅不限於主日。事實上,參加崇拜是容易的,耐心地與 同事、朋友、家人、甚至是教會内的同工,專心聆聽及合作, 支持照顧最弱勢的人——這是困難的。那些是真正屬靈操練考 驗的場所。所有這些東西不限於星期日進行,乃是通過六日在 世界上的生活。若你明白這個概念,你便會明白我為何說:敬 拜從來沒有結束過,敬拜的延續就是我們的腳蹅出教會的門的 那一刻。

雅各並沒有抹煞上帝豐富的恩惠,無條件的愛,雅各承繼 歷代猶太人對上帝的理解及認識,肯定上帝的供應是至美好 的,祂的愛是無止境的。就是保羅談及因信稱義的道理的時 候,引用亞伯拉罕作為借鏡,成為代表人物。亞伯拉罕是信行 合一的例子。亞伯拉罕因著信聽見上帝的呼召,他拾起包袱離 開原本的家鄉吾以。亞伯拉罕因信上帝甚至願意犧牲他的兒子 以撒。若果保羅所談及的亞伯拉罕是因信稱義的先例,亞伯拉 罕的信是帶有行動的。雅各是為這個真理加上印證。他提醒信 徒要為信仰付上活生生的見證,用行動表明一個看不見的信 念。教會生活的五個環節:敬拜,栽培,團契,服侍,宣揚。 教會的生活,從香港來到加拿大多倫多,我們帶著以往已經知 道的知識及模式在這裏繼續信仰的生活,但是模式與時代是息 息相關的,我願教會有像雅各所講的耐性,聆聽的耳朵,及願 意監察自己的心,面對我們今天的需要。

## LAST SUNDAY'S SERMON SUMMARY

"Earthly Saints" (James 1:17-27)

What do we do after we pray? I don't minimize the importance of prayer. But to build a loving and peaceful society, we need to hear the cry of James. May we never forget our social involvement. To love God is to love our neighbours. To build a good society requires our active engagement. Here James talks about generous acts of giving. These are not restricted to Christians, all generous acts are appreciated by God. James reminds us that our responses to God should not stay only on the cognitive side, but that we live them out. This leads us to the second point, that these activities are not limited to Sundays. In fact, to come to church to worship is easy, but patiently working with co-workers, friends, family members, and even fellow Christians at church is difficult. These are our true places to test our spirituality. All these things are not restricted to Sundays, but also for the next six days throughout the week. If you understand this idea, you would understand why I say: Worship never ends. The continuation of worship is the moment you step outside the church door.

James doesn't ignore the richness of God's grace and God's unconditional love. James inherits the ancient Jewish understanding of God and affirms that the provisions of God is good. God's love to us is without end, so much so that when Paul mentions the idea of justification by grace, he often uses Abraham as an exemplar. Abraham is a perfect exemplar on the unity of faith and action. When Abraham hears God's call, he left his hometown Er. Because of faith, Abraham is willing to even sacrifice his only son Issac. If Paul's understanding of justification has Abraham in mind, faith in God involves actions. James' message is to testify to his truth. He reminds Christians to be willing to put faith into action, to live out an invisible faith conviction. Will our actions change the world? I hope so. But this is an invitation to live. On November 1, 7:15, we will have the first outreach activity co-sponsored by Ebenezer United and Knox United Church. We call it: U-Talks: Stories to Inspire, Transform, and Empower - Conversations for the Love of World. It is an opportunity to show our concerns over our common questions about issues facing the world. It is an outreach event to invite our friends.

The authorities crucified him outside the city walls, but you raised him from the dead, and in his resurrection, you assured us that nothing can separate us from your love.

(All sing VU#466) Eat this bread, drink this cup; come to me and never be hungry. Eat this bread, drink this cup; trust in me and you will not thirst.

On the night before he died, he took bread, gave you thanks, broke the loaf, and passed it around the table, saying, "Take and eat; whenever you do this, remember me." When the meal was over, he took the cup, saying, "This is the new covenant, sealed in my blood; whenever you do this, remember me."

We remember Jesus in this way now, and with people through the ages, we proclaimed the mystery of faith:

# Christ has died, is risen, will come again to meet us, and walks with us the way of love, Holy Kingdom, come!"

# Breaking the Bread, Pouring into the Cup, Receiving the Elements

The bread of life, broken for you and me. **Thanks be to God.** The cup of blessing, poured out for you and me. **Thanks be to God.** These are the gifts of God for the people of God. Now come and eat, for the table is ready.
